Nature of Damage:

• Nymphs and adults suck the cell sap from the lower surface of the leaves

• Irregular dry patches on leaves

• black fungi develop on leaves



Management of sugarcane Pyrilla:

- Release *Fulgoraecia* (=*Epiricania*) *melanoleuca* @ 4000 to 5000 viable cocoons and 1 lac eggs/ha during rainy season.
- Release of minimum 1000 viable cocoons of an ectoparasite,
 Fulgoraecia (=Epiricania)
 melanoleuca during the month of
 - July to August found helpful in quicker establishment of parasite.
- Avoid burning trash after harvest if *Fulgoraecia* (=*Epiricania*) *melanoleuca* parasite established.
- Avoid use of insecticides in the plots where, *Fulgoraecia* (=*Epiricania*) *melanoleuca* parasite is established.
